

## Ribbon Cross

Complimentary Pattern by Timeless Handwork

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Cut out graph using 10 count clear plastic canvas and very small scissors. Cut out blackened areas. Use any color yarn that matches ribbon, and divide yarn into two plies, using only one for stitching. (Or use a full strand of embroidery floss). Work in slanted stitches across bars. Overcast blackened edges and outside edges with same or contrasting color, working 3 stitches in corners for good coverage.

For ribbon, cut a fairly long piece of 1/4" wide ribbon, about 18". Place center horizontally across bars, weaving ends down through vertical side bars. You should have two long ends of ribbon on back side.

Then pull both ends up through back of top cutout, coming through to front side.

Lift first side to side ribbon up and weave ends underneath. Pull ends to bottom cutout and go down through. Trim ends to about 5" evenly.
